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**Purpose of Request:**

The purpose of this ordinance is to set the Ad Valorem tax (millage) rate for the Gainesville Board of Education for the Fiscal Year 2018.

**History/Background:**

On September 6, 2017 the Gainesville Board of Education (BOE) tentatively voted to set the Fiscal Year 2018 millage at a rate of 6.85 mills. On September 7, 2017, the City received notification from the BOE to move forward with the adoption of the millage ordinance.

**Facts & Issues for Consideration:**

In order for the City to bill property taxes on behalf of the BOE, the ordinance must be adopted to set the rate at 6.85 mills. Property tax bills are scheduled to go out October 2, 2017.

**AN ORDINANCE**

**No. 2017-24**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, GEORGIA, TO FIX THE AD VALOREM TAX RATE FOR THE GAINESVILLE BOARD OF EDUCATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2018; AND OTHER PURPOSES.**

**BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

**WHEREAS**, a budget has been established for the Gainesville Board of Education for Fiscal Year 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, a specified amount of revenue for this budget comes from ad valorem taxes.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED** by the Governing Authority of the City of Gainesville, Georgia as follows:

**SECTION I.** In accordance with Act No. 64 (HB 841) approved March 4, 1993, and OCGA 48-5-32, the ad valorem tax rate for the Gainesville Board of Education for the calendar year, on property subject to ad valorem taxation by the City is hereby fixed at \$6.85 on each \$1,000.00 of property subject to ad valorem tax in the City.

**SECTION II.** Said rate of \$6.85 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable property is hereby levied as follows:

- (a) For maintenance and operations \$6.85 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable property.
- (b) For debt service \$0.00 on each \$1,000.00 of taxable property.

**SECTION III.** All ordinances and part of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the City of Gainesville Tax Office shall bill property taxes in one installment and collect payment of said taxes which shall be due on or before December 1, 2017.
