Mayor Dunagan called the meeting to order at 3:00 PM and served as the presiding officer.

NOTICE OF MEETING:

City Attorney Abb Hayes stated the meeting was called with less than 24 hours' notice due to the special circumstances and emergency declared by the City of Gainesville related to the COVID-19 pandemic. The emergency conditions related to COVID-19, which involve public safety and the preservation of property and public services, allow the meeting to occur by teleconference, and means are being afforded for the public to have simultaneous access to the meeting.

RESOLUTION:

Business Resolution 2020-17

Rescinding Resolution BR-2020-13, BR-2020-14, BR-2020-15, BR-2020-16 Related to COVID-19 and for Provisions Related to Same

Mayor Dunagan stated that due to the issuance of Executive Order No. 04.02.20.01 by the Governor of the State of Georgia, the referenced resolutions would be rescinded.

City Attorney Abb Hayes summarized the Governor's order (a shelter-in-place order) which mandates the suspension of any city/county order relating to the pandemic. The purpose of this resolution is to eliminate conflicts with the Governor's order. All residents are required to shelter-in-place unless abiding by one of the four exceptions stated within the order. The proposed resolution rescinds previous resolutions and restates nine provisions to remain cohesive with what has been occurring in the City of Gainesville.

City Manager Bryan Lackey commented on the possibility of confusion and indicated the City's website will be updated to provide the Governor's Order and other related documents.
