BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

Section 3-4-61 of the Code of the City of Gainesville, Georgia is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3-4-61. Speed Laws Applicable.

Pursuant to Chapter 6 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, Code Sections 40-6-181, 40-6-184, 40-6-185, and 40-6-188 of that chapter known as the Uniform Rules of the Road are hereby adopted as and for the traffic regulations of City of Gainesville with like effect as if recited herein.

SECTION II

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III

If any portion of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining portions unless it clearly appears that such other parts are wholly and necessarily dependent upon the part held to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION IV

This ordinance is enacted as an amendment to Section 3-4-61 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Gainesville, Georgia.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 3-4 ENTITLED “MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, GEORGIA; TO AMEND SECTION 3-4-181 ENTITLED “SPEED LIMITS ON SPECIFIED STREETS” BY ELIMINATING IT IN ITS ENTIRETY AND SUBSTITUTING IN ITS PLACE THE LANGUAGE SET FORTH BELOW; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR CODIFICATION; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF GAINESVILLE, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

Section 3-4-181 of the Code of the City of Gainesville, Georgia is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3-4-181. Speed Limits on Specified Streets.

- (a) The speed limits on specified streets within the City of Gainesville shall be as set forth in the list of speed limits on specified streets, which shall be kept in the City Clerk's office, as well as in the City Public Works Department's engineering section. Speed limits on specified streets can only be changed through City Council resolution.
- (b) The specified streets upon which speed detection devices are permitted and authorized shall be as set forth in the list of specified streets upon which speed detection devices are permitted and authorized, which shall be kept in the City Clerk's office, as well as in the City Police Department.

SECTION II

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION III

If any portion of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect or impair the remaining portions unless it clearly appears that such other parts are wholly and necessarily dependent upon the part held to be invalid or unconstitutional.

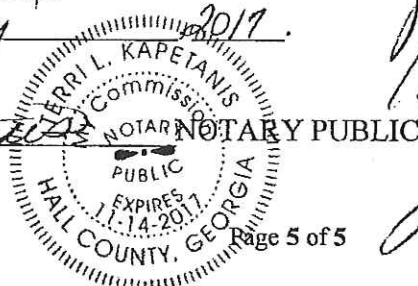
