DEPARTMENT ISSUES:

Resolution: Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding Program Grant

Police Chief Jay Parrish stated the department has an opportunity to receive non-matching grant funds (\$43,680) which would be used to sanitize the building every 4 to 6 weeks or anytime coronavirus incidents occur. The proposed resolution authorizes acceptance of funds from BJA.

CITY MANAGER ISSUES:

City Manager Bryan Lackey shared the following:

1. Identified the facilities reopening on May 18. The public will have access from 10 AM to 4 PM.
2. Shared the Fiscal Year 2021 budget approval process indicating the recommended budget will be presented at the May 28 Work Session. A public hearing will occur at the June 2 Council Meeting. Adoption will occur at the June 16 Council Meeting.
3. The Transportation Forum Virtual Meeting will occur on May 20 at 11 AM.

Ordinance: Amend Chapter 6-16 Entitled Licenses Permits and Business Requirements

Assistant City Manager Angela Sheppard stated the proposed ordinance addresses a few housekeeping matters related to pawnbrokers and second hand dealers. In summary, it replaces references to "City Marshal" with "City Manager or Designee", allows administrative approval of pawnshop applications to streamline processes and expands enforcement to include Code Enforcement Officers.
